## Quick Installation Guide

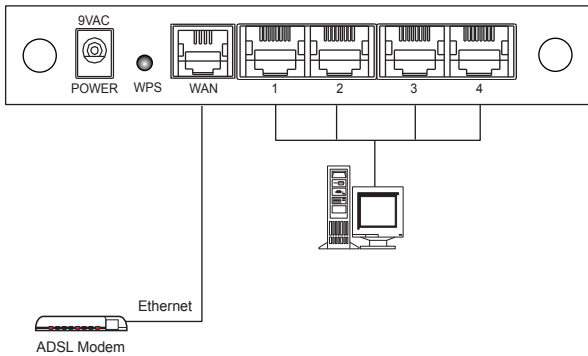
### Installation & Setup

#### LAN Connection

Connect an Ethernet cable from your PC's Ethernet port to the LAN port of the Wireless 11n Router.

#### WAN Connection

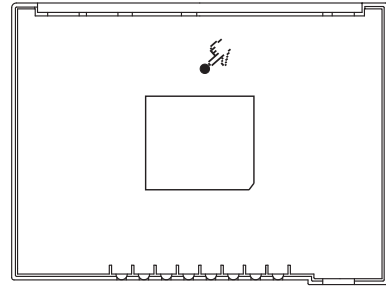
Connect the RJ-45 cable from ADSL / Cable Modem to the WAN port of the Wireless 11n Router.

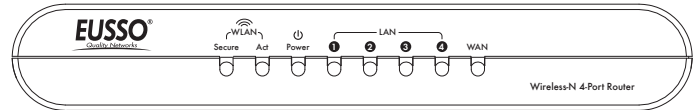
#### Reset Button

The reset button is on the underside of the router.



#### Power Adapter Connection

Connect the power adapter to the power inlet and turn the power switch on from the front panel of the Wireless 11n Router.

### Configuring Wireless 11n Router with Web Browser

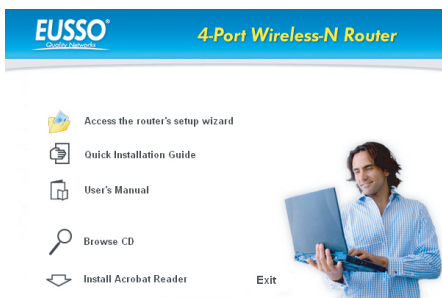
Open web browser and type <http://192.168.0.1> in the browser's address box. This number is the default IP address for this device.
